

## **STEPHEN FAWCETT, PH.D**



Dr. Stephen B. Fawcett is Kansas Health Foundation Professor of Community Leadership and University Distinguished Professor of Human Development at the University of Kansas. He is also Director of the KU Work Group on Health Promotion and Community Development of the Schiefelbusch Institute for Life Span Studies. In his work, he uses behavioral science and community development methods to help understand and improve health and social concerns of importance to communities. A former VISTA

volunteer, he worked as a community organizer in public housing and low-income neighborhoods. Dr. Fawcett has been honored as a Fellow in both Division 27 (Community Psychology) and Division 25 (Experimental Analysis of Behavior) of the American Psychological Association. He received the Distinguished Practice Award of the Society for Community Research and Action and the Higuchi/Endowment Award for Applied Sciences. He is co-author of over 100 articles and book chapters and several books in the areas of health promotion, community development, independent living, and public policy. He is co-developer of the Community Tool Box, a widely used Internet-based resource for promoting community health and development. A former Scholar-in-Residence at the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences, he currently serves as a member of the IOM's Board on Health Promotion and Disease Prevention. Dr. Fawcett has been a consultant to a number of private foundations, community partnerships, and national organizations, including the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation, the Ewing Marion Kauffman Foundation, the California Wellness Foundation, the U.S. Commission on National and Community Service, and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
