

CHPPD Tips and Tools for using the CHPPD Wiki

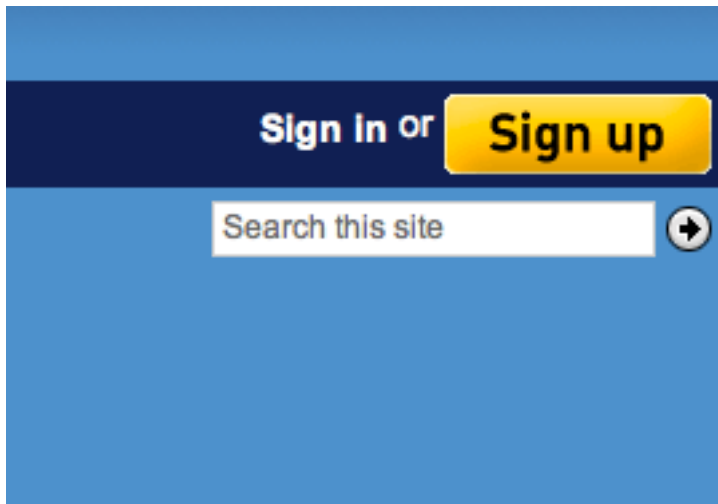

CHPPD uses a number of social networking and technology based websites to keep in touch with members. It is important members utilize these helpful websites and tools to understand what is currently occurring within the CHPPD Section and its committees, as well as being able to reference archive minutes and documents. I have created a few easy tips and steps for setting up your username and password to the CHPPD Wiki page. Creating a CHPPD Wiki member account

Go to the CHPPD Wiki website via Wetpaint: <http://chppdweb.wetpaint.com/>

First, all CHPPD members should sign up for access to the CHPPD Wiki page. To sign up, look to the far right for the below yellow “Sign up” button and click on it:



After clicking the yellow “Sign up” button, the below window should appear. Fill in the information and keep your new username and password, somewhere where you will remember it
