Please include the following information with your submission:

- Your name
- Your APHA membership ID#

- Articles *must* include a proposed title
- Optional (but preferred): Your headshot in .jpg or .gif format

And follow these formatting guidelines:

- 12-point font size
- Arial font
- 300 words or less
- Single-spaced
- Please do *not* insert a tab at the beginning of a paragraph
- Please insert only *one* space between sentences in a paragraph. Do not insert two spaces.

Articles must be related to this issue's theme: Epidemics, Natural Disasters & Disaster Preparedness. Some example topics could be:

- Local, state or national public health events or projects that you may have been involved in (e.g., H1N1 immunization planning, vaccination social marketing campaigns, involvement in earthquake relief efforts, and other various topics dealing with disaster preparedness and natural disaster relief efforts)
- Public health events or news at your school (e.g., research you worked on that has something to do with the issue theme)
- Public health related career advice
- Advocacy efforts
- Other news of public health importance and/or importance to students of public health

Please include a relevant photograph in .jpg or .gif format where appropriate for possible publication.
