
HOW CLIMATE CHANGE AFFECTS YOUR HEALTH

56,575 cases of West Nile Virus in the U.S. since 1999, of which more than 2,776 people have died.¹

Four states

reported locally-acquired cases of malaria in 2023, including the first in Texas in nearly 30 years and the first in Maryland in nearly 40 years.²

Lyme disease incidence has doubled over the past two decades to **30,000 Cases per year**.⁴
