2017-2018 Accreditation Support Initiative Affiliate Sub-Grantees

The American Public Health Association has awarded funding to seven Affiliates with support from the Office of State, Tribal, Local and Territorial Support within the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, to conduct activities that prepare local, tribal, state and territorial health departments for national public health accreditation. The proposed activities are innovative and will support health departments working toward accreditation and those beginning to learn about the process. Some of the proposed activities include: A full day in-person workshop covering the relationship between three domains and the foundational public health services model; onsite training to three local health departments who are in the process of achieving PHAB national accreditation; and establishing a process for linking public health professionals with accreditation experience to serve as mentors with participating local health departments.

The Affiliates will implement activities October 1 to June 30, 2018.
