AND NOT ALL BACKGROUND CHECKS ARE EQUAL.

Deaths from gun homicides and suicides **decline only** when background checks are part of a purchaser licensing system.

After Connecticut adopted its **licensing law**, it saw:

40%

drop in gun homicides **15**%

drop in gun suicides

In contrast, available research examining the impact of background checks without licensing found no reduction in gun homicides or suicides.

State background check laws generally fall into one of three categories:

No background check required for private transfers

Licensed dealers process background checks for all transfers License required and background checks for all transfers

Virginia, Pennsylvania and **Connecticut** are representative of these three approaches.
